Before the Meeting Preparation:

Compose a 1/4 page information sheet for the inside of Investiture invitations and make enough copies for everyone in the troop. Fold sheets of paper in half. Provide a selection of cut out pictures of flowers girls could paste on the cover of the invitation, or outlines of flowers girls could paste on the cover of the invitation and color.

Girls can provide some of the food needed for the Investiture Ceremony. **Prepare a reminder note for families with specific instructions as to what to bring to the Investiture Ceremony.** Let the girls make some of the selections and vote on them during today's Daisy Circle. Troop leaders will provide the rest of the supplies using troop monies.

Mark spots on floor where girls are to stand during the Investiture Ceremony (horseshoe, straight line, etc.) **Bring developed photos with you!**

Goals II and III: Relating to Others and Developing Values

Supplies and Equipment

Pre-Meeting Activity - approximately 10 minutes

Set out small invitation cards for Investiture Ceremony and supplies. Girls select flower options and paste to front cover and color as needed, paste the information sheet on the right hand side of the inside of the invitation and personalize the invitation to their parent(s).

Folded half sheets of paper, glue sticks, Investiture information sheet, flowers cutouts, crayons (if needed)

If possible, place tables against the wall, leaving center of room open.

Opening Activity - approximately 15 minutes

Use the Quiet Sign to gain girls attention. Ask girls to find one of the spots you have placed on the floor (arranged in a horseshoe). Open by reciting the Girl Scout Promise with the girls. Read the Girl Scout Law. Sing *Make New Friends* or song of choice.

Floor spots - if you think you will use them later (great for games), make them out of vinyl or laminate paper spots.

Daisy Circle (Business & Snack) - 10 minutes

Sit down where they are. Pass out snack and talk quietly among themselves. Explain that the Investiture Ceremony will take place at the next meeting. Check to make sure all girls have their invitations completed. Explain what will happen at the ceremony and where they will stand, just like they did today. Ask them what refreshments they would like to have to celebrate. **Hint—Offer a limited selection!**

Recipe cards

Main Activity - approximately 15 minutes

Conclude playing the Daisy Girl Scout *Promise Path Game*. Assist girls with reciting the Promise. Place girls in groups or two for recitation so as not to single out girls who are struggling with learning the Promise.

Refer to attachments (after Meeting 6) for instructions and graphics.
Crayons or fine-line markers

Clean-Up - approximately 10 minutes

Girls assist leaders with resetting the room. Sweep floor and tidy up as necessary.

Kaper Chart

Closing Activity - approximately 5 minutes

Girls collect belongings and put on coats. They find their buddy and skip around the room until they find another pair to link up with. Continue until all girls are linked together. Form a circle. Sing "Make New Friends". Say, "Good-bye Daisy Girl Scouts!" Remind girls to take home their Investiture invitations.
